SYNOPSIS

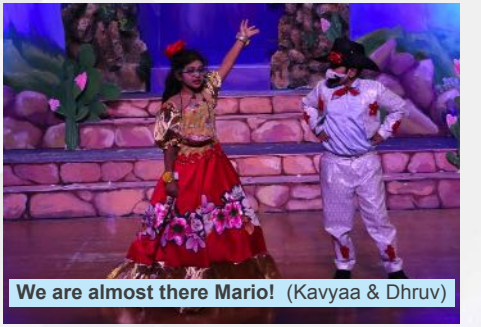
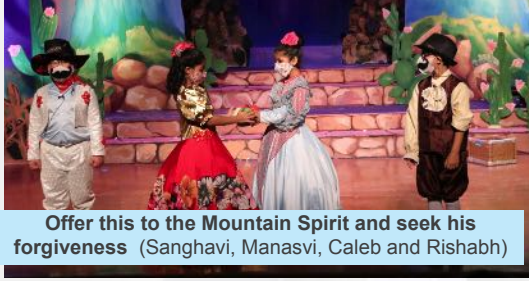

Eliana, as narrator, transports the audience to a place in a time and prepares them for a major conflict in the play.



Matthew, the Judge, is the powerful voice of the justice system. The dramatic opening, reminds the eight jurors of their legal responsibilities. The confident delivery by Matthew sets the tone of the play.



Natasya, the helpless defendant, expresses her plea for mercy, supported by the synchronized movements of the graceful dancers Ananya, Pari, Sanjana, Tvisha and Yoma. The dance choreographed by Ananya and Pari to a diegetic music aptly orchestrates the plight of the defendant.



The jurors from L-R Gayatri, Hiya, Ermando, Chavella, Jiwon, Sneha and Tanvi all set for a quick verdict as Robert, the Foreman, calls for order and discipline - "If we want to discuss it first and then vote, that's one way. Or we can vote right now to see how we stand."



L to R - Gayatri, Hiya, Ermando, Chavella, Sneha, Robert, Jiwon and Tanvi. A reveal of the eight jurors all set to hand out a verdict to the fifteen-year-old boy. The lighting cue and the positioning of the characters create anticipation of what is to follow.



A moment of tension and foreboding - the eight jurors deliberate the fate of the defendant. Gayatri, is forceful and convincing, 'I just think he's guilty. I thought it was obvious from the word 'go'. Nobody proved otherwise'



Ermando, navigates a spectrum of emotions from rage to manic support as he confronts Sneha, "Since when is dishonesty a group characteristic? Do you think you were born with a monopoly on the truth? I think certain things should be pointed out to these respectable members of the jury"



Eliana adds to the mood of the moment that highlights how the self-interests of the jurors, Hiya, Gayatri, Sneha, Chavella, Tanvi and Robert are challenged by Ermando. Eliana's energetic rendition perfectly captures the rising conflict and musically communicates hope through the unfaltering righteousness of Ermando as Juror 8.



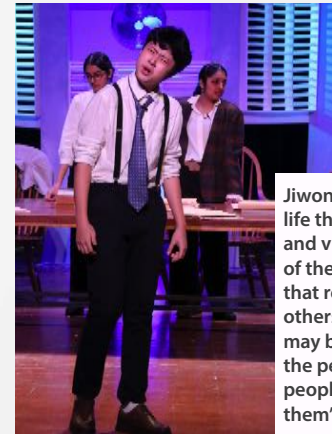
Kezia's powerful rendition creates a lingering sense of gravity of the plight of the defendant.



Emotions peak when Ermando, as Juror 8, creates a dent in the case. The second knife, a valuable evidence, deliberately presented by Juror 8 leads to a cacophonous crescendo of rage and disbelief, enacted by, L to R - Robert, Hiya, Gayatri, Jiwon, Sneha, Chavella and Tanvi.



The jurors from L to R - Robert, Ermando, Hiya, Gayatri, Chavella, Tanvi and Jiwon - listen as Sneha, one of the jurors, gives vent to her grievances as a parent - "I haven't seen him in two years. Rotten kid!"



Jiwon, brought to life the honesty and vulnerability of the character that reminds the others that "Facts may be coloured by the personalities of people who present them".



The magical combinations of sound, rhythm, melody and charm depict the internal conflict of Jiwon as he deliberates his judgement in the case. The lithesome movements of Chaewon, Yejin, Yumin, Ananya and Pari highlight the frenzy and confusion of Jiwon in his struggle to come to a decision.



L to R - Robert, Jiwon, Gayatri, Hiya, Chavella and Tanvi watch in disbelief as Sneha convinces Ermando - "The boy is five feet eight inches tall. His father was six two. That's a difference of six inches. It's a very awkward thing to stab down into the chest of someone who's half a foot taller than you are."

GRADE 3 STUDENTS VISIT THE NATIONAL MUSEUM - JAKARTA

Artifacts help us learn and appreciate our past. To build a better understanding of this the students of Grade 3 went on a field trip to the National Museum on 2nd November 2022.

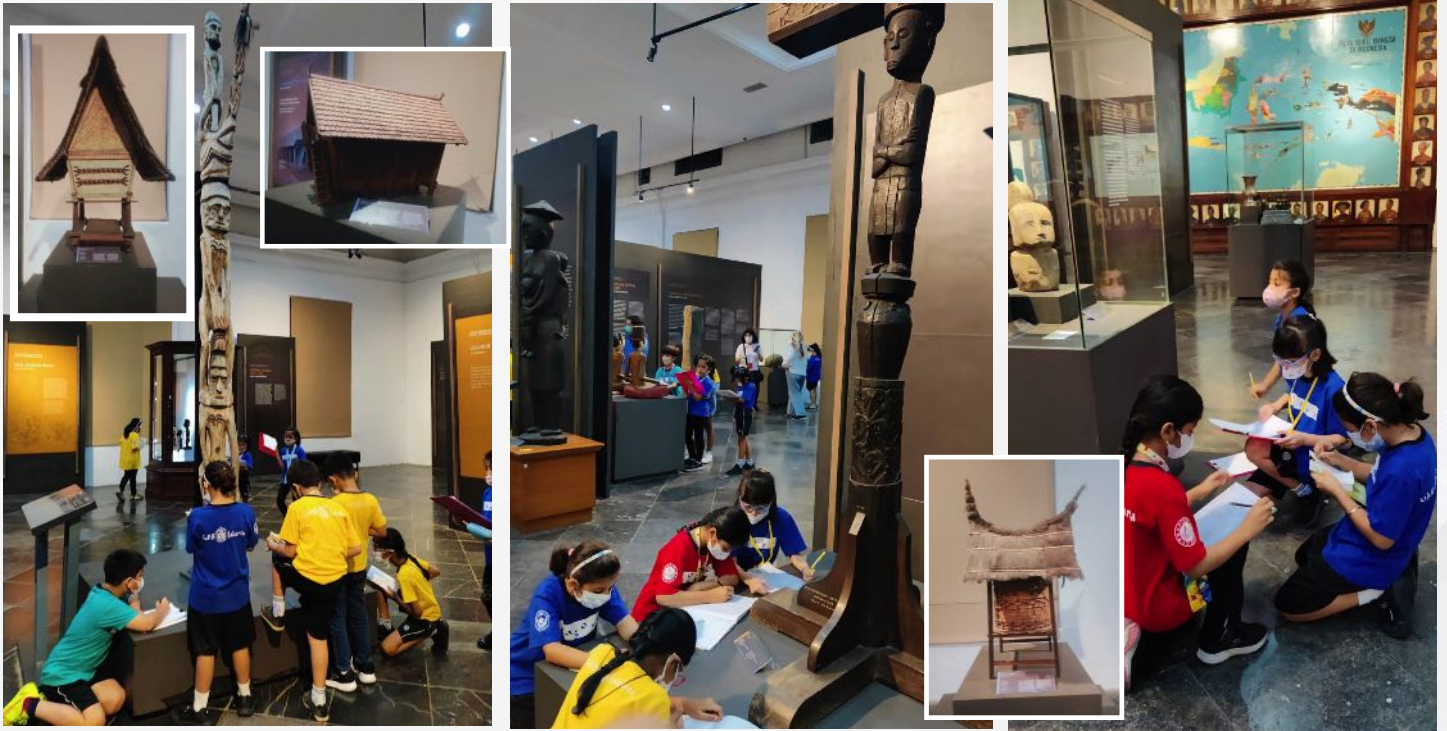
The famous National museum in Jakarta has artifacts depicting the life of early men.

The students took great interest in observing and inquiring

about the artifacts. The queries and the discussion about the various artifacts displayed their inquiry skills.

After returning to the class they did a reflection about their field trip. They even brainstormed on the IB learner profile and attitude developed during the trip.

The field trip activity was concluded with a booklet activity about their trip, where students expressed their experience.

GRADE 4 STUDENTS VISIT MEKARSARI FRUIT GARDEN

Going to the lap of nature has immense benefits for all ages. Being mindful of the stress that each individual has gone through as we lived through COVID, the Grade 4 students and teachers wanted hands-on learning in the greens as part of their inquiry into the role of plants in the ecosystem and our connection to the environment. Brainstorming in this unit under the Transdisciplinary theme "Sharing the Planet", the student posed inquiry questions about, why trees are important? How are we all connected? And what effect do trees have on us? Their inquiry questions could only be answered through experiential learning in the lap of nature, hence they boldly embarked on a field trip to Mekarsari Fruit Garden on November 8th, 2022. As they reflected on the role that the trees played in our lives, they came upon research about the emotional effects of nature on man. This was a line of inquiry that the students pursued in their trip, from being thankful for the produce that they could pick in the lush fruit gardens or just sitting and enjoying with their friends in the sprawling lawns. Each child felt joyful and happy. Another interesting research that the students came across was the "hug a tree" project, which showed that people have a higher "happiness quotient" when they hug a tree. The brave "Inquirers" of Grade 4 and their teachers, went forward and tried this...the feeling of peace and awe that they felt after they overcame their initial inhibitions left most adults and children amazed. In the words of one of the students, "we should do this everyday" truly sums up the life long lessons they learned.
